Compensation: According to the Bureau Labor of Statistics, a licensed Cosmetologist working for a national chain salon is usually an hourly wage of at least \$22.04 per hour in the 90th% percentile and up to \$45,840 Annually Salary, plus an incentive production plan or commission. Licensed Manicurists is \$15.43 at an hourly wage and in the 90 percentile \$32,100 annually salary. Many of larger chain salons also offer insurance and benefits package that nowadays is worth so much more than just a monetary gain. In the majority of salons, you can expect to make a sales commission on the retail inventory of the salon, as well. Whether you decide on booth rental or private salon ownership, you will feel a personal satisfaction that is both profitable and rewarding.

Physical Demands of the Profession

The demand for employees in service careers has shifted the trend for some typically college-bound students to choose shorter, more specialized educational paths for careers in the service industry. Cosmetology is one of the service careers that are seeing this surge of interest. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the most in demand careers between now and 2012 do not require a four-year degree. A career choice in one of these fields requires less than a year, in some cases, of specialized training. Making a choice to enter into the beauty industry, including cosmetology, manicuring, and shampooing will bring not only personal satisfaction, but also a sense of security for many years to come.

Safety Requirements

While the majority of your day requires long hours of standing much of that time, proper posture can be beneficial to your health and help you to present a positive attitude. Well-made shoes will benefit you in health and the safety aspect of the salon. It is best to wear closed-toe shoes with a low heel for best fit and comfort. Proper blood-spill, as directed by the State Law of the Board of Cosmetology and wearing gloves during all chemical applications is an example of the many safety concerns in this field. A large portion of the Cosmetology classroom theory and practical classes is aimed toward safety in the salon, in order to keep the client and themselves safe at all times.
